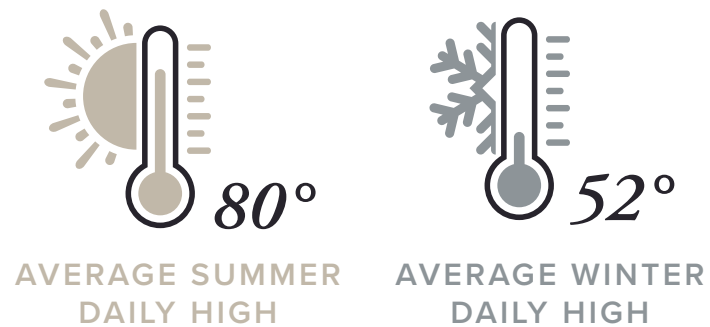

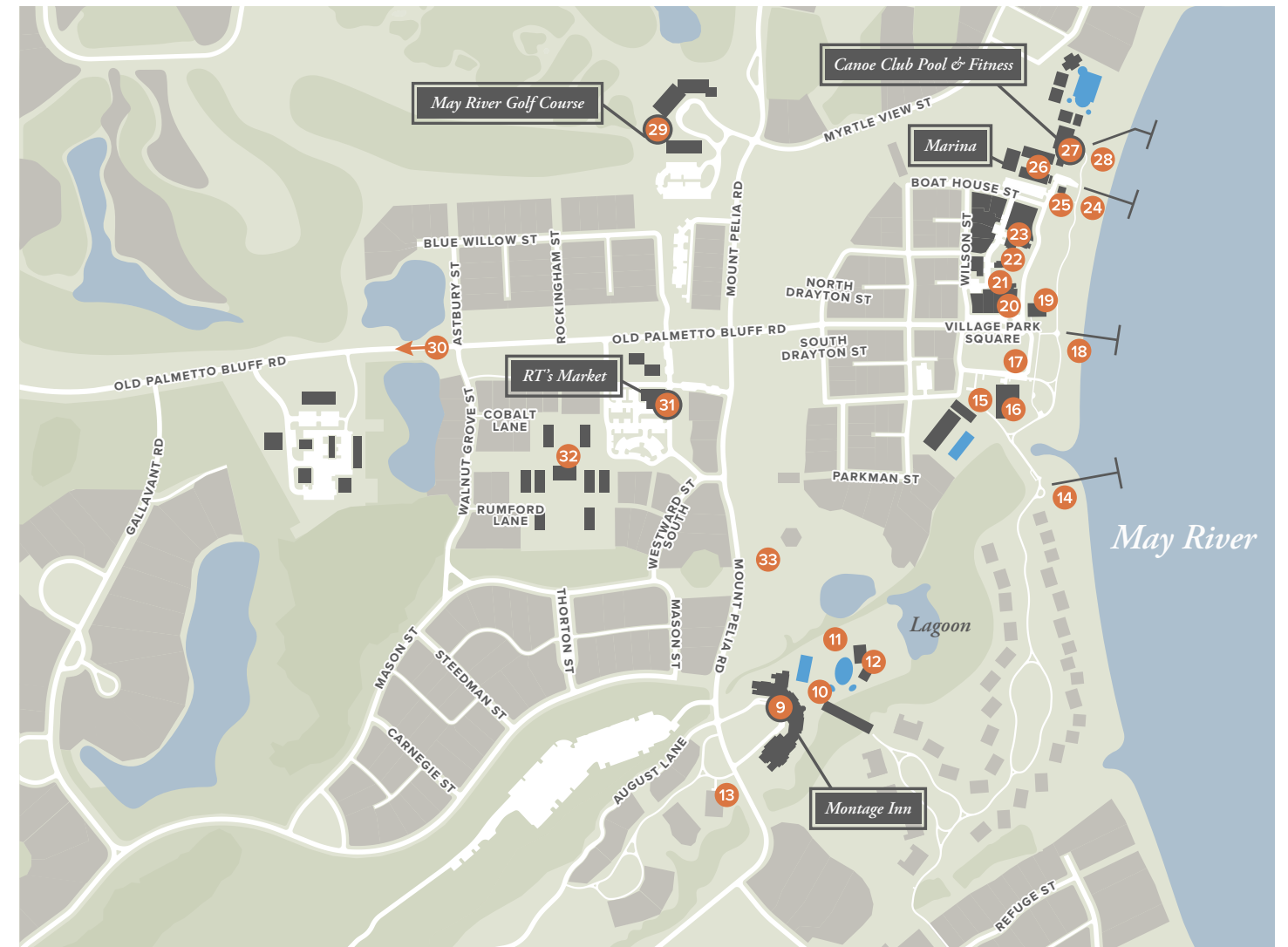

YOU'VE GOT A LOT OF OPTIONS FOR DINING AND DRINKS.

### THE OCTAGON PORCH & BAR

At *The Inn, The Octagon Porch and Bar* serve a Southern-infected menu inside and on the porch. Breakfast includes an eggs benedict made with homemade cornmeal English muffins and a southern ham. The fried chicken sandwich on the lunch menu is a crowd favorite.

### THE RIVER HOUSE

Comforting and elegant, *The River House* showcases a curated assembly of seasonal ingredients and vegetables served alongside thoughtfully sourced meats and seafood. Bespoke cocktails and curate wines add to the experience, creating unforgettable nights of Lowcountry dining.

### THE CANTEEN

*The Canteen* is the perfect spot in *Moreland Village* to pick up a cup of coffee or breakfast sandwich in the morning and a homemade panini, a wrap, a salad or snacks in the afternoon. Take it to go or enjoy an afternoon on the *Canteen's* open-air porch with a glass of wine or a beer from a local brewery.

### BUFFALO'S

The gathering place for all – and a community favorite – here at *Palmetto Bluff*. The corner café sitting across from our chapel in *Wilson Village*, *Buffalo's* offers its patrons picturesque views of the May River as they enjoy a menu featuring everything from market-fresh salads, Italian sandwiches and pastas, pastries and handmade local gelato to wines by the glass or bottle and a variety of signature cocktails and local craft beers.

### FLAME

Expect mobile mozzarella from the folks behind *Flame*. Artisanal pizzas, Italian comfort foods, and salads are Specialties Of The Truck – a vintage 1950's model stationed in *Moreland Village*. Come for the Woo-Fired lasagna, stay for the S'mores Focaccia.

### MELT

If you wander along the banks of the beautiful *May River*, you'll find *Melt*, in *Wilson Village*. Featuring 12 'signature southern ice cream' flavors, plus shakes, sundaes, floats, candy, homemade cookies, brownies and more, this friendly and inviting sweets shop is almost impossible to resist.

### RT'S MARKET

Named for the merchant *Richard Thornton Wilson Sr.*, the father of the early 20<sup>th</sup> century owner of *Palmetto Bluff*, *RT's Market* is your neighborhood general store, and so much more. Here you can pick up your morning newspaper and coffee, top of your gas tank, and buy milk and bread for the next day's breakfast or the ingredients for preparing a gourmet meal for a house full of guests. *RT's Market* offers a creative selection of high-quality products – an extensive wine selection, gourmet items, seafood and meats and gifts.

**MAY RIVER GOLF COURSE**

Designed to challenge golfers of all skill levels, the 18-hole Jack Nicklaus Signature Course meanders through the May River Forest and features wide, inviting fairways with strategic bunkers and natural waste areas. Champions Bermuda greens, lined by white-sand bunkers, test your nerves, while gently undulating slopes challenge your putting skills. All tee boxes and fairways feature Paspalum, the newest eco-friendly turf.

Caddie service is required with each round, and we encourage you to walk the course so you can best appreciate the beautiful native landscape.
