


CLIMATE

WHAT IS PALMETTO BLUFF?

Nestled in the lush Lowcountry of South Carolina between Hilton Head and Savannah, and set amid 20,000 acres along the May River in Bluffton, SC, Palmetto Bluff is a luxurious, one-of-a-kind resort for the avid outdoor lover.



HISTORY

In 1902, Richard T. Wilson, Jr., a wealthy New York banker, purchased 10,000 acres of land along the May River and over the next 20 years, he doubled the size of his property and named it "Palmetto Bluff." The Bluff was the Wilsons' winter home and a place to relax, hunt, and ride.

The natural beauty of the May River, with its lush marshlands, mangroves, and estuaries, provides a stunning backdrop for Palmetto Bluff's water-centric activities.



YOU'VE GOT A LOT OF OPTIONS FOR DINING AND DRINKS.

THE OCTAGON PORCH & BAR

Located at *The Inn*, serving a Southern-infused menu inside and on the porch. Southern favorites include eggs Benedict, Bourbon French Toast and a fried chicken sandwich.

THE RIVER HOUSE

Comforting and elegant, *The River House* showcases a curated assembly of seasonal ingredients and vegetables served alongside thoughtfully sourced meats and seafood. Bespoke cocktails and curate wines add to the experience, creating unforgettable nights of Lowcountry dining.

BUFFALO'S

A favorite family spot for dining in *Palmetto Bluff*. This beloved corner café sitting across from the iconic *Chapel* in *Wilson Village*, *Buffalo's* offers its patrons picturesque views of the *May River* as they enjoy a menu featuring everything from market-fresh salads, Italian sandwiches and pastas, pastries and handmade local gelato.

CANOE CLUB

Located in *Wilson Village*, overlooking the inland waterway and adjacent to the *Canoe Club* pool, you can enjoy casual fare with views of the *May River* and an ever-changing seasonal menu.

THE CANTEEN

The perfect spot in *Moreland Village* to pick up a cup of coffee or breakfast sandwich in the morning and a homemade panini, a wrap, a salad or snacks in the afternoon. Take it to go or enjoy an afternoon on the *Canteen*'s open-air porch.

COLE'S

Located in *Moreland Village*, offering members and guests a chance to bowl a few frames either before or after dinner in the adjacent *Boundary Bowling Alley*. What better way to experience the Lowcountry than with a taste of traditional Southern cuisine. Cole's favorites include brisket tacos, Coles' Famous Fried Chicken and Spiced Buffalo Chicken Salad.

FLAME

Expect mobile mozzarella from the folks behind *Flame*. Artisanal pizzas, Italian comfort foods, and salads are specialties of *The Truck* – a vintage 1950's model stationed in *Moreland Village*. Come for the Woo-Fired lasagna, stay for the S'mores Focaccia.

MELT

The best way to stroll the *Village Green* in *Wilson Village* is with an ice cream cone in hand! Head to *Melt* ice cream shop, featuring 12 'signature southern ice cream' flavors, plus shakes, sundaes, floats, candy, homemade cookies, cookies, brownies and more.

CANOE CLUB

This incredible resort style pool is the jewel of Palmetto Bluff's Wilson Village and a hub for members and guests throughout the year. The Canoe Club includes an expansive saltwater swimming pool and bubbling Jacuzzi.

The pool at The Boundary is located in Palmetto Bluff's Moreland Village with its modern-meets-rustic design that blends seamlessly into the marsh and tidal landscape that is the backdrop for this charming neighborhood village. GOLF COURSES

MAY RIVER GOLF COURSE

Designed to challenge golfers of all skill levels, the 18-hole Jack Nicklaus Signature Course meanders through the May River Forest and features wide, inviting fairways with strategic bunkers and natural waste areas. Champions Bermuda greens, lined by white sand bunkers, test your nerves, while undulating slopes challenge your putting skills. Caddie service is required with each round, and walking the course is recommended.

CROSSROADS

Nestled in the picturesque landscape of Palmetto Bluff, a challenging new option for golf lovers now exists — the Crossroads 9-Hole Golf Course. Completed in January 2024, Crossroads, is a 60-acre reversible golf course, ensuring a seamless experience for 18 holes. The Crossroads course at Palmetto Bluff promises a unique and engaging experience for golfers of all skill levels.
